On September 8, 2006, Brookewood School opened its doors to 56 girls from throughout the metropolitan area. It was an initiative of The Avalon Education Group (AEG) to provide single sex education to girls. AEG had opened The Avalon School for boys three years earlier. We are very proud of our current students and our graduates. We are confident that they will make a profound influence in our culture for the good through family life, social life, and professional life well-lived.

The information contained in this folder is only one step in learning about the youngest girls' school in Montgomery County. When you have reviewed the enclosed materials, we invite you to arrange a tour and an interview. You may also schedule a date in which your daughter can visit the school for a day so that she can get a closer look at Brookewood.

To consider your daughter for admission, Brookewood requires the following:

- A shadow visit
- The application for admission together with a \$75 application fee
- The recommendation of at least one teacher
- A current academic transcript
- The family interview

New students are admitted through many factors - academic achievement and promise, extracurricular activities and interest, and other personal qualities that will enhance the student body. And, because Brookewood School regards education as a joint venture with mothers and fathers, we also seek families who will support the goals and ideals of the school as it works with their daughters to make for a more human, more vital society.
