

## SCHOOL PROFILE 2024-2025

**B**rookewood School is an independent, Catholic, K-12 college preparatory day school for girls offering a balanced program in the liberal arts and fine arts as well as religion classes in accordance with the Catechism of the Catholic Church. Brookewood was founded in 2006. The school's first senior class graduated in May 2010. There are 231 students total; 143 in grades K-8 and 88 in grades 9-12. There are 26 students in the class of 2024.

Brookewood is approved to operate an elementary and secondary school by the Maryland State Department of Education. Brookewood has 25 full-time and 8 part-time faculty members.

### Grading Scale

There are two semesters with end-of-term exams in January and June. Grades are scored: A 90-100, B 80-89, C 70-79, D 60-69, F 0-59.

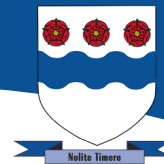

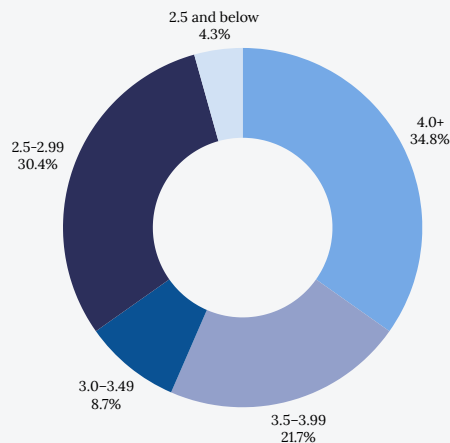

### Advanced Placement

Brookewood had 36 students take a total of 60 exams in May of 2024. Of the 60 test scores, **92% of the exams scored a 3 or higher.**

**97% of the students** taking the exams received at least one exam score of a 3 or higher.
